



Spring Term 1

Students will learn about all the different styles of Graffiti from recent to modern and question whether Graffiti is Art or vandalism and investigate the British value of mutual respect

Students will develop the skills from year 7 on shading and learn the skill of colour blending using pencil crayon. They will learn how to create Graffiti lettering and images and develop individual work based on the artist's studied and their own creative ideas.

Students will study the Pop artists discover how they were influenced by the second world war and American consumerism. They will learn how to create a research page, develop both observational drawing skills and skills in different art media. They will then go on to develop individual final outcomes based on food in the style of the Pop artists.

Summer Term 2

Students will learn about the artists Andy Warhol and contemporary artist Julian Opie. They will learn how Warhol has influence Opie and discuss the similarities and differences. They will create their own work in the Pop art style developed by the artists.

Students will recall the blending skills learnt in the Graffiti project and extend these in different art media. They will study the work of different artists such as Warhol, Ernest Haeckel and Kate Osbourne. They will create work that mixes these ideas together to create an individual final outcome.

Students will recall how bugs and butterflies have been used in different artist's work and study Steam punk. They will use their drawing skills, computer skills and learn three-dimensional modelling skills to create Steam punk bugs.
