ART

Architecture



Students will learn about different styles of architecture. They will question how architects are inspired and create their own architectural drawings inspired by different objects.

Art and Architecture Drawing Skills



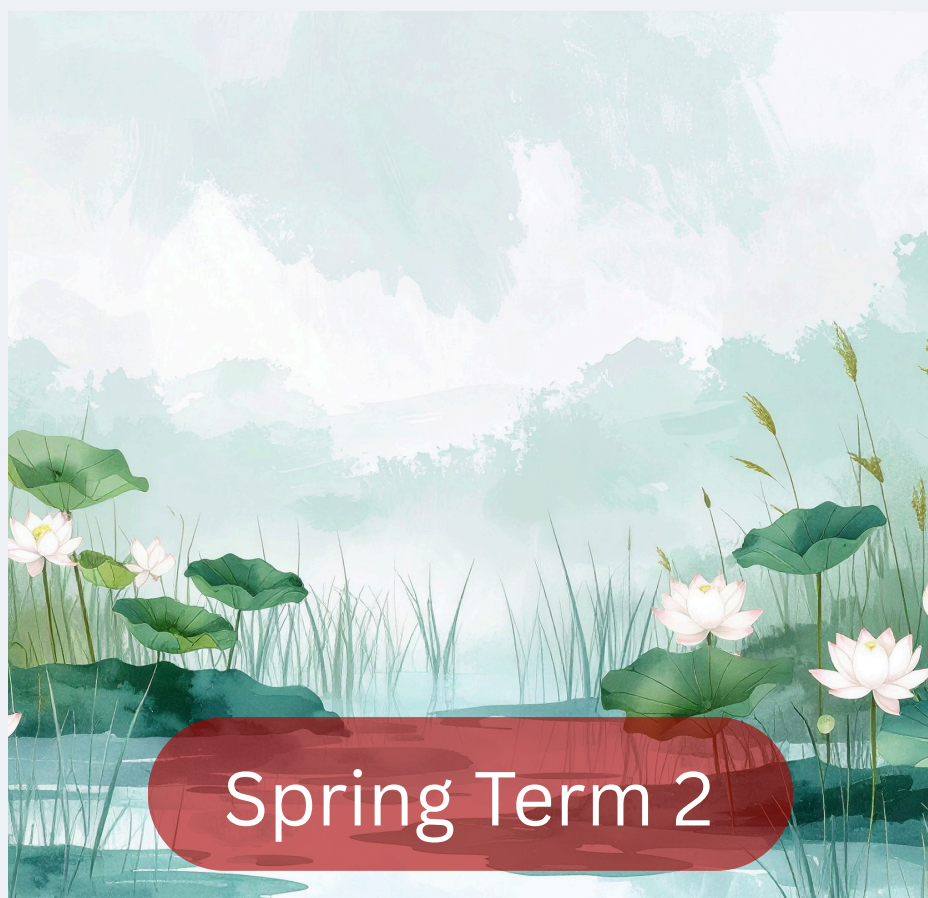
Students will develop the skills on observational drawing and shading and learn how different artists have been inspired by architecture and use their drawing skills to work in the style of the artist Ian Murphy.

Art and Architecture 3D Skills



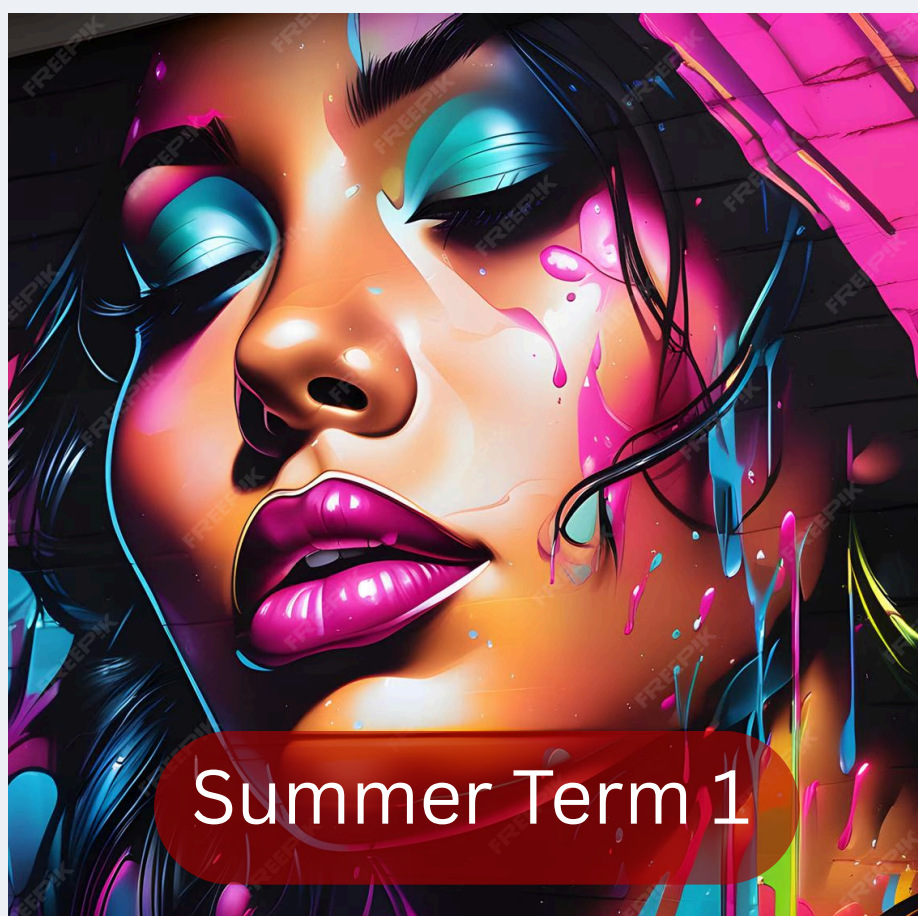
Students will study the artwork of Joshua Smith and Michael McMillen and develop their collage and three-dimensional modelling skills to create maquettes to develop ideas.

Art and Architecture Media skills and outcome



Students will develop watercolour skills in the style of Marc Allante and graphic design skills in the style of Lobo and then develop individual work based on the artist's studied and their own creative ideas.

Students will study artists who use Graffiti style art to create portrait murals. They will learn how artists can take traditional skills into contemporary art; they will develop their analysis skills, fine tune observational drawing skills and skills in different art media during term 5.
