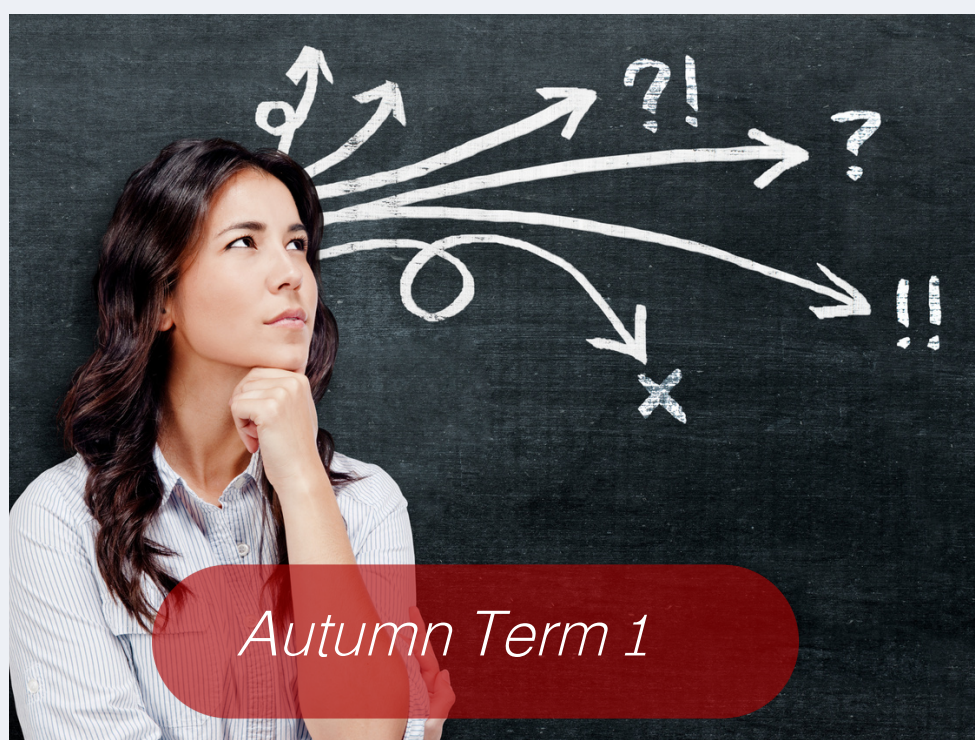




# YEAR 10 LEARNING JOURNEY INFORMATION

**How can I make smart financial decisions?**



*Autumn Term 1*

We will learn how to manage money responsibly as we move towards adulthood. We will explore credit, debt, taxation, financial products, budgeting and consumer awareness, developing confidence in making financial decisions.

**What makes an adult relationship healthy and respectful?**



*Autumn Term 2*

We will learn about the qualities of healthy adult relationships. We will explore coercive control, communication, consent, sexual harassment, online reputation and ways to recognise and respond to unhealthy behaviours.

**How can I recognise and challenge extremism?**



*Spring Term 1*

We will learn how extremist groups attempt to influence and recruit individuals. We will explore radicalisation, online extremism, hate crime, prejudice and social justice while developing the confidence to challenge harmful narratives.

*Spring Term 2*

We will learn about workplace expectations and employability. We will explore professional behaviour, CV writing, interviews, applications and career pathways to prepare successfully for work experience and future employment.

*Summer Term 1*

We will learn how experiences in the workplace can help us develop transferable skills and shape future ambitions. We will reflect on work experience, evaluate feedback and identify strengths to support future career planning.
