## History

Your Year 7 History journey begins in Roman Britain, exploring invasion, control and resistance. You will then study the Vikings and the events of 1066, before discovering how the Normans transformed England. You will examine power struggles between kings and the Church and finish with Henry VIII and the Break with Rome. It's a journey through conquest, power and change!

## Geography

Year 7 Geography takes you on a journey from the UK to the wider world. You will explore your local area, build map skills and discover how people and landscapes interact. You will investigate oceans and climate change, study powerful countries like China and Russia, examine rivers and end the year exploring UK landscapes such as the Yorkshire Dales.

## Religion and Citizenship Studies

In Year 7 Religion and Citizenship, you will explore the big question "Where do we belong?" You will learn about the world's major religions, focusing on Christianity and Islam, and how beliefs, places of worship, celebrations and festivals help give people a sense of identity and community in modern Britain.



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
