Results Collection

Results will be available for collection on:

Thursday 20 August 2026

Time: 8.30am – 10.30am

Location: Main Hall

Students are encouraged to collect their results in person. Members of staff will be available throughout the morning to provide support, advice and guidance regarding post-16 education, training and employment opportunities.

If You Are Unable to Collect Your Results

If you are unable to attend in person, there are several alternative ways to access your results:

Email

Results will be emailed to your school email account at approximately 9.00am on Results Day. Please ensure that you are able to access your account before Results Day. If you require assistance, please contact the school office via office@westcraven.co.uk

Please note that school email accounts can only be accessed within the UK and cannot be accessed from abroad.

Education Record App for Students

If you have downloaded and logged into the DfE Education Record App, your results should be available from 11.00am. If you have not yet logged in, you will need to obtain a QR code from school. You will need to make an appointment to come in to school to validate your account before the end of term. It is a quick process but must be done by a member of the school team.

Collection by a Nominated Person

You may nominate someone to collect your results on your behalf. The nominated person must bring:

- A letter signed by the student giving permission for the nominated person to collect the results.
- Photographic identification for themselves.

Post-Results Services

Information about post-results services, including reviews of marking, clerical checks and access to examination scripts, will be provided with your results.

Students wishing to discuss any of these services should speak to a member of staff as soon as possible, as examination board deadlines are strictly enforced.

Enrolment for Further Education

Students should follow the enrolment arrangements provided by their chosen sixth form, college or training provider. Many institutions will require evidence of examination results as part of the enrolment process.
