Year 11 Period 6 Revision and Support Programme

As we begin this important academic year, we are pleased to introduce our **Year 11 Period 6 Revision and Support Programme**, which will commence this week.

These after-school sessions have been carefully designed to provide students with additional opportunities to consolidate their learning, strengthen subject knowledge, develop examination techniques and engage in focused revision in preparation for their GCSE examinations. Prom Attendance Incentive

To encourage regular attendance and reward students for their commitment to their studies, we are introducing a **Prom Attendance Incentive Scheme**. For every completed week of attendance at the Revision and Support Programme, **£1 will be credited towards the cost of a student's Year 11 Prom ticket**. Attendance will be monitored and recorded by teaching staff. For the purposes of this incentive:

- Three sessions attended and logged by teachers will count as one completed week.
- Each completed week will earn £1 towards the cost of Prom.
- Contributions will accumulate throughout the academic year based on attendance records.
- Students who attend 25 or more completed weeks of the Revision and Support Programme will receive a free Year 11 Prom ticket.

We hope this initiative will encourage students to take full advantage of the support available while recognising their dedication and commitment to their studies.
